7.51 Explain the institution and impact of missionaries on Christianity and the diffusion of Christianity from Europe to other parts of the world in the medieval and early modern periods.

Monasteries

- The Catholic Church established many monasteries during the Middle Ages
- Monks lived, worked, and <u>prayed</u> together
- Monks were responsible for <u>copying texts by</u> <u>hand</u>
- Monasteries eventually started <u>schools</u> and <u>hospitals</u>

Missionaries

- Eventually, <u>missionaries</u> would leave monasteries in groups to spread their message and <u>convert</u> new Christians
- Missionaries first went to <u>Africa</u> and <u>Asia</u>
- Converting new Christians became a main reason that European countries <u>explored</u> and <u>colonized</u> the New World
