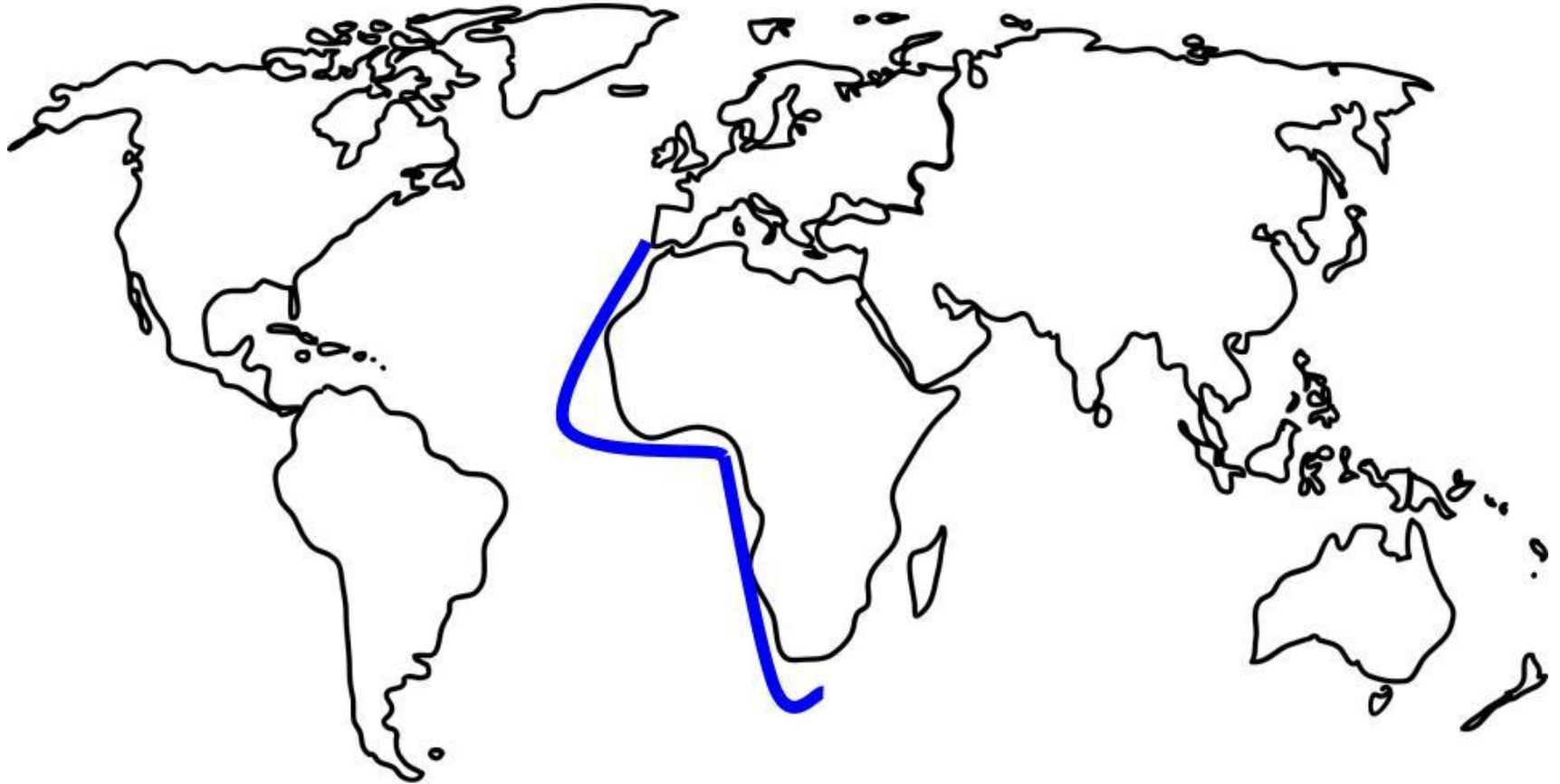


7.58 Identify the voyages of discovery, the locations of the routes (Da Gama, Dias, Magellan), and the influence of cartography in the development of a new worldview

Bartolomeu Dias

- Left Lisbon, Portugal in 1487 looking for a sea route to India
- Discovered the Cape of Good Hope on the southern tip of Africa
- First to discover that the Atlantic and Indian Oceans touch
- Once he reached the southern tip of Africa, decided to turn back for home

Vasco da Gama

- Left Portugal in 1497 to finish the trip Dias was supposed to complete
- First European to travel to India by sea
- Became Viceroy of India in 1524

Ferdinand Magellan

- Left Spain in 1519 looking to travel around the world by sea
- Left with 5 ships to go west around the Americas to get to the other side of India
- In March 1512, reached Philippines where Magellan was killed by natives on the island
- One ship of original 5 made it back to Spain in 1521
