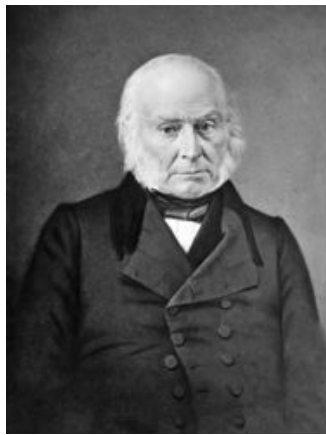


James Madison (1809-1817)
Democratic-Republican
Virginia

1. President during War of 1812
2. In White House when it burned
3. 2 vice presidents died in office
4. Never had a job outside politics



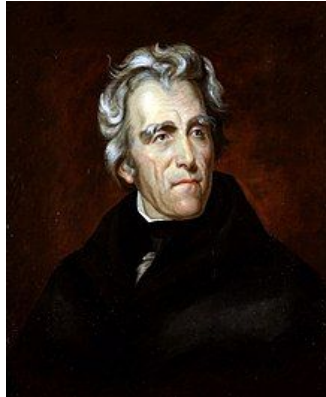
John Quincy Adams (1825-1829)
Democratic-Republican/ National
Republican
Massachusetts

1. Wanted to modernize infrastructure
2. Started a National Road
3. Wanted to end slavery
4. Helped start Smithsonian Museums



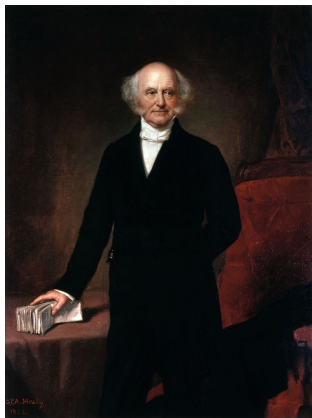
James Monroe (1817-1825)
Democratic-Republican
Virginia

1. Wrote Monroe Doctrine
2. 5 new states added
3. Got Florida from Spain
4. President during Missouri Compromise



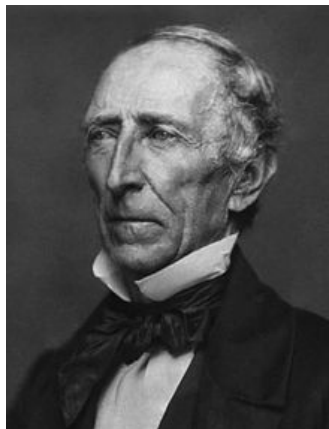
Andrew Jackson (1829-1837)
Democrat
Tennessee

1. Signed Indian Removal Act
2. Led westward expansion
3. Took more power than previous presidents
4. Liked small federal government



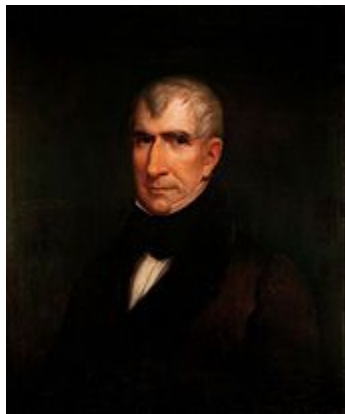
Martin Van Buren (1837-1841)
Democrat
New York

1. Poor economy
2. Trail of Tears
3. Refused to allow Texas to become a state
4. Peace with GB over land dispute in Maine/Canada



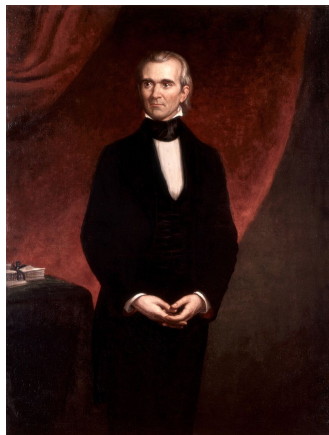
John Tyler (1841-1845)
Whig
Virginia

1. Over annexation of Texas
2. First VP to become President due to death
3. Log Cabin Bill--buy land before sale
4. Tariff Bill



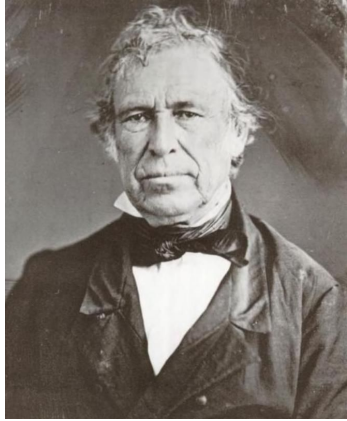
William Henry Harrison
(1841-1841)
Whig
Ohio

1. Only served for 1 month after catching pneumonia



James K Polk (1845-1849)
Democrat
Tennessee

1. Oversaw large expansion of US
2. Opened US Naval Academy
3. "54-40 or fight" but settled at 49th with GB
4. President during Mexican-American War



Zachary Taylor (1849-1850)

Whig

Kentucky

1. Large slave owner
2. Did not think states should be allowed to secede
3. Did not want new states to have slavery
4. Died in office after eating bad or poisoned food
