- Reunification: when a divided territory becomes one again
- <u>Dynasty:</u> line of rulers passed from parent to child
- <u>Grand Canal:</u> made to connect poor farmers with water for agriculture; longest artificial river in the world
- <u>Civil Service Exam:</u> tests created to determine if one can work for the government
- <u>Confucianism:</u> following the teachings of Confucius and the idea of harmony in relationships
- <u>Kinship:</u> family relations

- <u>Hierarchy:</u> system of organization where some people are ranked higher than others
- <u>Buddhism:</u> following the teachings of Buddha towards enlightenment
- <u>Taoism:</u> Chinese tradition of living in harmony
- Morality: understanding the differences between right and wrong
- <u>Neo-Confucianism:</u> belief based on Confucianism that the world could be understood with human reasoning

- <u>Silk Road:</u> trade route that connected Europe, Africa, Middle East, and China
- <u>Terrace farming:</u> farming system where steps are created into the side of a hill or mountain
- <u>Porcelain:</u> white ceramic material used to create vases, plates, and bowls
- Mongol: person coming from Mongolia, just north of China
- Genghis Khan: military leader of the Mongolian Empire

- Golden Horde: name used by Europeans to describe the Mongol army
- <u>Kublai Khan:</u> grandson of Genghis Khan who took control of China and moved the capital to modern day Beijing
- <u>Isolationism:</u> the policy of being closed off to other countries
- <u>Great Wall:</u> built by many dynasties; was created to protect China from the Mongols
- <u>Forbidden City:</u> palace complex built for the rulers of China
