<u>Clan:</u> group of related family members <u>Hierarchy:</u> system of organization where some people are ranked higher than others <u>Noble:</u> belonging to a higher ruling class. Also called "aristocracy." <u>Monk:</u> a male member of a religious community Zen: Japanese Buddhism focused on meditation <u>Shinto:</u> Japanese religion that believes everything has a spirit

<u>Animism</u>: belief that animals, plants, and other objects have spirits

<u>Calligraphy:</u> art of decorative handwriting

<u>Feudalism:</u> system of service between a lord and those

loyal to that lord

Lord: someone with power and influence over another in

the feudal system

<u>Shogun:</u> military governor who ruled Japan

<u>Daimyo</u>: one of the great lords loyal to the Shogun <u>Samurai:</u> Japanese warrior loyal to a daimyo <u>Ronin:</u> paid soldier who had no lord or master <u>Peasant:</u> a farmer with low social status <u>Artisan:</u> someone who makes things by hand <u>Bushido:</u> Samurai code of honor and morality
