- **Nullify:** make something legally invalid, cancel out
- Secession: the act of removal from a formal group, leaving a union
- **Spoils system:** the practice of giving jobs to members of your own political party

- **Veto:** the president's power to declare that bills from Congress will not become laws
- Indian Removal Act: signed by Andrew Jackson in 1803, forced all Native Americans west of the Mississippi River
- **Trail of Tears:** forced march of Native American tribes across the south to specific lands west of the Mississippi River
- **Manifest Destiny:** belief that the expansion of the US throughout the American continents was right and bound to happen
- **Mormon:** member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, migrated west from Illinois to Utah
- **Missionary:** person on a religious mission to convert others to their religion
- **Oregon Trail:** trail across the west taken by many people moving between Missouri and California
